Dear UNSW University Partner,

UNSW would like to update you on Scholarship opportunities through the Endeavour Awards.

The Endeavour Awards is the Australian Government's internationally competitive, merit-based scholarship program providing opportunities for citizens of the Asia Pacific, the Middle East, Europe and the Americas to undertake study, research and professional development in Australia. Awards are also available for Australians to undertake study, research and professional development abroad, and have been established to maximise the benefit to Australia of its extensive scholarship programs, and to support enduring ties between Australia and our neighbours.

In 2011, the University of New South Wales is proudly hosting approximately 70 Endeavour Awards Scholarship holders. **Applications are now open for the 2012 round of the Endeavour Awards** and we encourage any prospective students to consider the University of New South Wales – the destination of choice for scholarship and sponsored students.

In 2011, **UNSW** is rated as the state's top ranked university based on the Excellence in Research (ERA) for Australia report, which evaluated research activity and quality in the country's 41 higher education institutions.

Nationally, UNSW received the fourth highest rating – 4.04 of a maximum five – measuring its performances in all broad fields of research as "at, above or well above" world standard. In 33 subject areas, UNSW received the top or equal top rating, scoring five out of five in 19 of those areas:

Endeavour Research Fellowships

- Endeavour Research Fellowships (including Endeavour Australian Cheung Kong Research Fellowships) - Short Term Research only

Endeavour Postgraduate Awards

- Endeavour Postgraduate Awards Coursework and Research
- Prime Minister's Australia Asia Incoming Postgraduate Award Coursework and Research
