Το Υπουργείο Εξωτερικών διαβίβασε στην Υπηρεσία μας την υπ' αριθ. 013/10.01.2012 Ρηματική Διακοίνωση της Πρεσβείας της Ινδονησίας στην Αθήνα, σχετικά με τη χορήγηση υποτροφιών Darmasiswa, σε φοιτητές μέχρι 35 ετών που επιθυμούν να ασχοληθούν με την εκμάθηση Ινδονησιακής Γλώσσας, Τέχνης, Μουσικής και Χειροτεχνίας σε Πανεπιστήμια και Κολέγια της Ινδονησίας, για το ακαδημαϊκό έτος 2012-2013.

Προγράμματα που προσφέρονται:

1. Το **Regular Darmasiswa Program** διάρκειας ενός (1) έτους: για την μελέτη της Ινδονησιακής γλώσσας Bahasa Indonesia, της παραδοσιακής μουσικής, του παραδοσιακού χορού και της Ινδονησιακής χειροτεχνίας.
2. Το **Short Course Darmasiswa Program** διάρκειας ενός (1) εξαμήνου: μόνο για την μελέτη της Ινδονησιακής γλώσσας Bahasa Indonesia.
3. Το **Summer Course Program** διάρκειας τριών (3) μηνών: από Ιούνιο έως Αύγουστο.

Έναρξη προγράμματος: Αύγουστος – Σεπτέμβριος του 2012.

Οι υποτροφίες περιλαμβάνουν την απαλλαγή από τα δίδακτρα και τη χορήγηση 2.000.000.- Rupiahs μηνιαίως (περίπου 160 € μηνιαίως).

Δεν χορηγείται στέγη στους υποτρόφους του Darmasiswa Program, ωστόσο το αρμόδιο γραφείο Bureau for International Cooperation μπορεί να προσφέρει βοήθεια στην αναζήτηση ενός κατάλληλου καταλύματος.

Δεν καλύπτονται τα αεροπορικά εισιτήρια, ωστόσο καλύπτονται τα έξοδα από την Jakarta μέχρι το Πανεπιστήμιο που έχει επιλεγεί για το πρόγραμμα του υποτρόφου.

Καταληκτική ημερομηνία υποβολής αιτήσεων: Το αργότερο μέχρι την δεύτερη βδομάδα του Φεβρουαρίου του 2012 στο Υπουργείο Εθνικής Παιδείας της Δημοκρατίας της Ινδονησίας, μέσω της Πρεσβείας της Ινδονησίας στην Αθήνα.

Η ανακοίνωση των αποτελεσμάτων: το Μάιο του 2012. Όλοι οι επιτυχόντες θα πρέπει να επιβεβαιώσουν την συμμετοχή τους στο Πρόγραμμα μέχρι τις αρχές Ιουνίου του 2012.



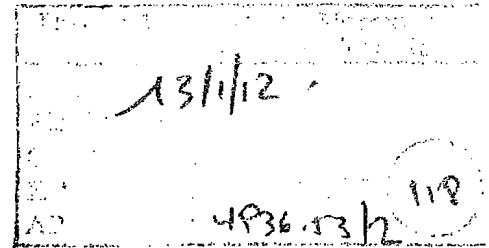

INFORMATION ON THE "DARMASISWA" PROGRAM OFFERED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA

I. INTRODUCTION TO THE DARMASISWA PROGRAM

Darmasiswa is a scholarship program open to all foreign students from countries with which Indonesia has friendly relations to study Indonesian language, art, music and crafts. Participants can choose to study at any of the state universities and colleges participating in the program.

The main purpose of the Darmasiswa program is to foster and encourage interest in the language and culture of Indonesia among friendly countries. It was also designed to reciprocate scholarship programs by other countries for Indonesian citizens and provide stronger cultural ties with these nations.

The Darmasiswa program is essentially a "non-degree" program undertaken within 6 month or a year. Its participants are prohibited from doing research, engaging in any political and/or business activities, which may result in destabilizing programs or lead to personal profit/gain.

During the course of the program, participants are strongly advised against making any changes in their place or study and/or university.

II. THE SCHEME OF PROGRAMMES

The Darmasiswa Program is offered with 2 schemes, i.e :

- **Reguler Darmasiswa Program - 1 year**
The program is a one-year scholarship program to study Bahasa Indonesia, traditional music, traditional dance, and Indonesian craft in selected Indonesian Higher Education Institutions.
- **Short Course Darmasiswa Program - 6 months**
The program is a six-month scholarship program only to study Bahasa Indonesia in selected Indonesian Higher Education Institutions.
- **Summer Month Program - 3 months**
The program will take place during the summer month (June-August). This program is intended to study very specific field, therefore it is strongly advised that the participant have a background from the same field.

III. THE SCHOLARSHIP COVERS

1. Exemption from tuition fee.
2. Monthly allowance in the amount of 2.000.000 Rupiahs per month (approximately 160 Euros).

- The Bureau for International Cooperation will send all allowances for the participants every month through the University/College where they are enrolled (except those who are situated in Jakarta). All participants can get their respective allowances by checking with their department whether their monthly stipends have arrived.
- All participants are advised to bring enough pocket money in preparation for their studies in Indonesia. This is because the monthly allowance from the Ministry will not sufficient to cover the monthly needs and accommodation.
- The Bureau for International Cooperation and the University/College will not provide any lodging or board to the participants of the Darmasiswa programme. The participant may rent a house/room in accordance with his/her preference and financial capacity. The Bureau may however, provide assistance to the participant in looking for a suitable boarding house/accommodation.

IV. THE BEGINNING OF THE STUDY

Students who are accepted for 1 year and 6-month program are expected to arrive at the beginning of August 2012 following by the orientation period for a month. The study activity generally begins during the first week of September 2012 except of students accepted into the University of Indonesia (Universitas Indonesia), which start in July 2012. For those who are accepted in the summer program should be in Indonesia at the beginning of June 2012.

V. QUALIFICATIONS OF THE APPLICANTS

To qualify for the DARMASISWA program the applicant should:

1. Have filled up the application form provided by the Ministry of National Education through the Indonesian Embassy at his/her country of residence.
2. Have completed High School Education or its equivalent.
3. Submit the copy of academic transcript.
4. Be not more than 35 years of age.
5. Be in good health as evidenced by a Medical Certificate duly signed by a doctor from their countries of residence.
6. Have submitted his/her application through the Indonesian Attaché/Embassy in his/her country of residence and have proof of his/her nationality in that country.
7. Submit five (5) recent photos measuring 4x6 cm attached with the application form.
8. Have a basic knowledge of the field he/she is applying for.
9. Submit a photocopy of his/her passport which valid for at least 18 months.
10. Be fluent in English for communication

VI. PROCEDURES

1. All applicants should have filled up the application forms provided by the Ministry of National Education through the Indonesian Embassy in his/her country of residence and submitted the abovementioned applications through the same office.
2. Applicants who have submitted complete application forms (3 copies) are then reviewed for selection as candidates for the Darmasiswa program.
3. All applications should be received by the Bureau for International Cooperation, Minister of National Education, Republic of Indonesia by the end of February of the year of commencement of the Darmasiswa program at the latest.

VII. THE ANNOUNCEMENT OF SELECTION

The result of selection is going to be announced in May 2012. All successful applicants are then requested to confirm their participation by the beginning of June 2012.

VIII. VISA ARRANGEMENTS

1. For their studies in Indonesia, the Darmasiswa participants are required to have a social visit visa issued by the Indonesian Embassy in the participants' country of residence.
2. Upon arrival in Jakarta, the Darmasiswa participant's passport has to be submitted to the Bureau of Planning and International Cooperation, Ministry of National Education, to be conversed to one-year residence permit in Indonesia.

IX. AIRFARE TICKET

The Government of the Republic of Indonesia does not provide the airfare return ticket of the participants from home country to Jakarta (the capital of Indonesia) and vice versa. However, the Ministry of National Education will cover the transportation expenses from Jakarta to the region where their selected university is located.

X. UPON COMPLETION OF STUDIES

1. Upon completion of one's studies, the participant is required to submit a written report including the grades obtained during the duration of one's stay in Indonesia. This report must be addressed to and acknowledged by

the Department Head of the University/College where the participant was last enrolled.

2. The participant must go back to his/her country of residence before his/her Resident Permit expires. The Exit Permit must likewise be obtained from the Immigration Office in Indonesia.

XI. OTHERS

The Darmasiswa program does not provide any health insurance; therefore the participants are expected to have international health insurance.
